COVID 19 Tests

If you feel you have symptoms of Covid you should take a test as soon as possible.

A test should be carried out within the first 5 days of your symptoms.

You can choose to take a test at an official Test site or with a home test kit.

If you are getting a test because you have symptoms, you and anyone you live with must stay at home until you get your test results. (self isolate).

You can also get a test for someone you live with if they have symptoms.

Covid 19 Symptoms check:

- 1. A High Temperature (feels hot to touch your chest or back)
- 2. A new continuous cough
- 3. A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Many people may have only one of the above symptoms, not all.

If you are not online – call 119 to book a test

Otherwise find the NHS test website and follow the instructions to book at a test site.

There are NHS sites online that can offer help and advice along with the GOV UK site.

If you need medical advice about your symptoms go to the NHS 111 Coronavirus online service for help and advice

The NHS are asking that you do not physically attend your GP Clinic or Hospital A & E, if you believe your symptoms could be Covid, but to get a test done asap.

Unfortunately, symptoms of the Winter Flu can be very similar but if you are unsure and feel unwell, call 111 for advice
